

# 2017 Murder Non-Negligent Manslaughter



### **DEFINITION**

The Federal Bureau of Investigation, Uniform Crime Reporting program has defined Murder as the willful killing of one human being by another.

The classification of this offense is based solely on police investigation as opposed to the determination of a court, medical examiner, coroner, jury, or other judicial body. Deaths caused by negligence, suicide, accident, or justifiable homicide are not included in this offense category.

### **ANALYSIS**

### **VOLUME**

The reported number of murders committed in Michigan in 2017 was 567. This was a three percent decrease in murders from 2016 and a ten percent decrease from 2013. More persons were murdered during the months of January and August; while fewer murders occurred in the month of December. Murders occurred most often on Saturdays and least often on Thursdays.

### **CRIME RATE**

The murder rate in 2017 was six murders for every 100,000 persons. The murder rate in 2016 was also six murders for every 100,000 persons.


### **CLEARANCES**

In 2017, forty-eight percent of all murders were cleared by an arrest or exceptional means. Exceptional clearances can be reported when one of the following circumstances has occurred: Death of Offender, Prosecution Declined, In Custody of Other Jurisdiction, Victim Refused to Cooperate, or Juvenile/No Custody.


### **NATURE**

Of the 567 murders, sixty-seven percent were committed by the use of a firearm (firearm, handgun, rifle, shotgun, and other firearm including automatics of these categories). Knife/Cutting Instrument was the weapon of choice in ten percent of the reported cases and Personal Weapon in five percent of the cases.


### **Victims by Month**




## **Victims by Day**



5-Year Trend








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


### Age of Victims




### **Age Analysis**

Nineteen percent of the victims were between the ages of 25 and 29. In 2016, this age group also reported nineteen percent of the victims.



### **Gender Analysis**

Forty-nine percent of the Female victims were Black and forty-seven percent were White. Seventeen percent of Female victims fell into the 20 - 24 age group.



### **Race Analysis**

Seventy-four percent of the Male victims were Black and twenty-five percent were White. Twenty-one percent of Male victims fell into the 25 - 29 age group.

### 2017 Robbery



#### **DEFINITION**

Robbery is the taking or attempting to take anything of value under confrontational circumstances from the care, custody, or control of a person or persons by force, threat of force, or violence and/or by putting the victim in fear of immediate harm.

### **ANALYSIS**

#### **VOLUME**

The number of offenses for Robbery in Michigan for 2017 was 6,486. This is a reported decrease of nine percent from 2016 and a thirty-seven percent decrease from 2013.

The largest number of offenses occurred in the month of July; the least amount were committed in February.

#### **RATE**

The crime rate for this offense in 2017 was 65 for every 100,000 persons, which is a ten percent decrease from 2016.

### **CLEARANCES**

Law enforcement agencies cleared 1,174 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance of the 6,466 incidents reported. This is a reported eighteen percent clearance rate.


### **NATURE**

In 2017, Robberies that occurred on a Highway/Road/Alley accounted for forty percent of the offenses. Residence/Home accounted for nineteen percent of the offenses.


The weapon most used in the commission of these Robberies was a Handgun at thirty-eight percent, which includes Automatic Handguns. Personal Weapons were used in twenty-five percent of the offenses.


Carjackings are classified as a Robbery with a motor vehicle marked stolen. In 2017, there were 509 offenses of Carjacking. There were 472 that occurred in 2016, which is an eight percent increase.

## Offenses by Month




# 5-Year Trend
